Description of Business Sessions/Meetings:

"Focus on HD" Community Meetings/Dinners: Led by the committee co-chairs, this will be an update and organizational meeting for each committee's latest projects. This includes discussing industry needs and potential solutions, and creating work groups as needed. Each committee meeting is open to anyone who is interested in the committee's goals, but listed members of each committee should try to attend.

Current committees for CVSN are Legislative, Industry Awareness, Education, and Technology.

- **Business Services Provider (BSP) Introductions** Essential to the long-term evolution of the industry, our BSP's provide new tools and services that can enhance any of our members' work place and profitability. This session allows each BSP attending company to give a 2-minute commercial on what their company offers, which they can then go into further detail with at their tabletop display in the Clubhouse throughout the conference.
- **Pillar Presentation / Speaker Sessions:** These sessions start with a public update by the co-chairs of that pillar to the full group on the latest committee projects and activities, followed by a speaker presenting on a relevant topic.
- Spotlight Presentations: These are designated 30-minute sessions for supplier sponsors as well as distributor members to present their respective companies' strategic direction and initiatives. In the designated 30-minutes time slot, the spotlight companies will deliver two identical 20-minute presentations, with a 5 minute intermission for attendees to switch rooms for an opportunity to hear both presenting companies during that time frame. Distributor can only attend Supplier spotlights and suppliers can only attend distributor spotlights.

- One-Off Meetings in the Clubhouse: Running simultaneously with the spotlight presentations, scheduled one-off
 meetings will be available in the Clubhouse for new introductions or partner specific conversations. Each
 attendee can designate up to two spotlights presentations to skip for potential one-off meetings.
- CVSN Clubhouse: The designated "social" meeting area for all attendees that will host most receptions and will
 include tabletop booths for business services providers (BSP's), semi-private meeting areas, public relaxation
 areas, food and beverage throughout the day, and much more. Similar to a coffee shop style break room, this
 area is perfect for learning about new tools for your business, catching up on e-mails, and meeting new industry
 influencers.

Description of Social / Charity Activities:
